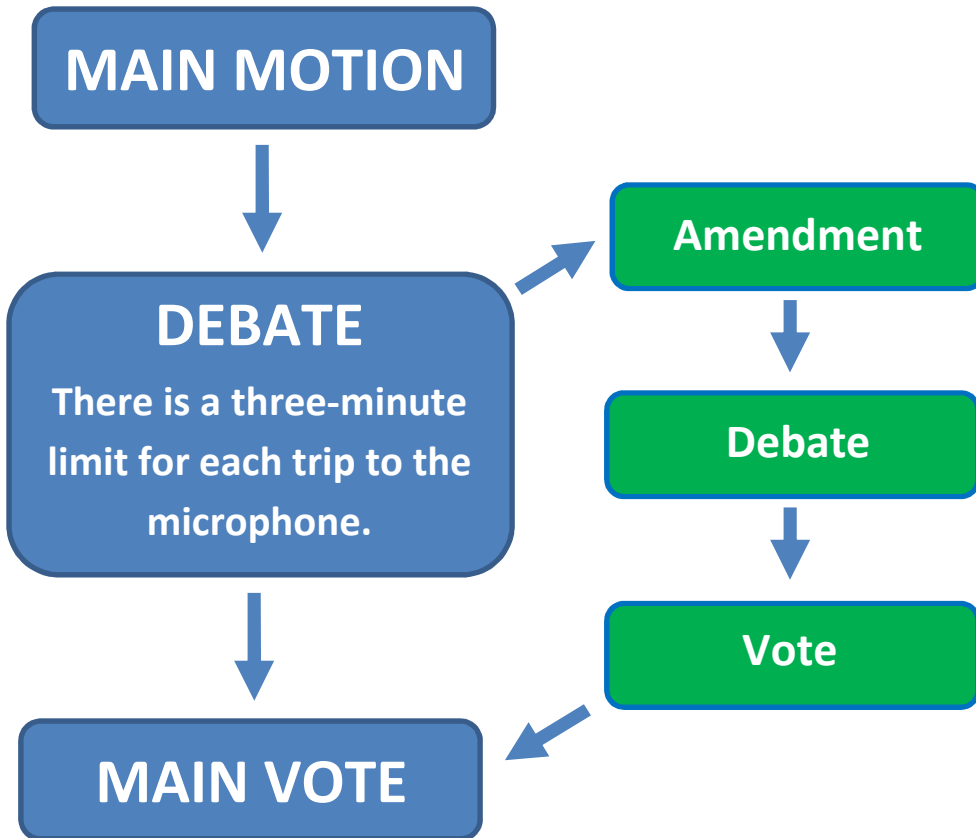


# PARTICIPATING IN GHI'S ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS USING ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER



Debate Interrupting Motions	
Parliamentary Inquiry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Used to ask the current state of the situation or to determine what the outcome would be if approved or disapproved.</li> <li>•"I call a parliamentary inquiry."</li> </ul>
Point of Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Used to request additional information on the matter being discussed.</li> <li>•"Point of information"</li> </ul>
Point of Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Used if a member feels a breach of the rules has occurred.</li> <li>•"Point of order."</li> </ul>
Previous Question	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Used to bring debate to an end. Requires 2/3 vote to end debate and vote on the motion being debated.</li> <li>•"I call (or move) the question."</li> </ul>
Lay on the Table	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Used to stop debate and hold further discussion/decisions until a future date.</li> <li>•"I motion to table the proposed motion (or amendment)."</li> </ul>
